

Code Flags for St. Petersburg












Inspired by nautical code flags that are used by navies and ships around the world, Code Flags for St. Petersburg uses a six flag and code system to facilitate dialog among attendees of Art Prospect. Participants hoist code flags on the flagpole and use them to communicate with people at the other flagpole. They can answer your questions and perform actions that you suggest. They have the same code and can communicate back to you, creating a dialog.

How it works

- » Find helper at flagpole.
- » Use flag code key to find a question or command that you want to communicate to the other flagpole. This will require hoisting one or a combination of two flags.
- » Hoist flag or combination of flags on the center flagpole line.
- » Look for answering pennant from other flagpole.
- » Let other flagpole ask you a question.
- » Repeat.
